Street Science

Bell State School is passionate about every student succeeding and are striving to make a significant positive impact on our students learning and wellbeing. We were recognised as a perfect candidate for the Federal Government, SISTA Project. The SISTA Project, delivered by Street Science is a federally backed initiative designed to inspire and promote equity in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) education for girls in primary schools across Australia. We have entered into a 3 year partnership with Street Science and the government has subsided this program by \$1600 a year for our school.

It involves classroom activity kits, teacher professional development and additional Street Science lesson resources, regularly digitally streamed in class lessons and a live Science Show on the 29th April. This will be for all students from Prep-Year 10. The cost is \$10 per student and invoices will go home this week.

We would like to offer our thanks to the Western Downs Regional Council Library in Bell who are running a free STEM PUNKS incursion—Space 101. The program takes students on a journey of exploring the future of space exploration with hands-on workshops to learn new STEM skills applied in real-world problem solving.
